Policard Partnership Update.

Due to the unrest in Haiti, it has been over two years since we last visited Policard. In that time there have been several major changes. Pastor Eloi Fortin began his ministry in August of 2021. In 2022, our partnership was blessed to provide a solar power system for the School, Parsonage, and Church building. This system has been a great blessing to the Policard Church and the community. This year we hope to provide a computer lab for the school. They plan to use this lab to train students and to set up a small printing business that will provide some funds and bless the community since the only printing service available is almost an hour drive down the mountain. The Policard school currently has over 200 students and could add more if there were more classrooms. Lives are being eternally changed as the gospel is proclaimed. Education is the key to a better future for Haiti. Thank you for supporting Policard with your prayers and financial donations. Please pray for rain which will allow them to grow the food they desperately need. Pray also for the nation of Haiti. Pray for wise government leaders who lead with integrity.
