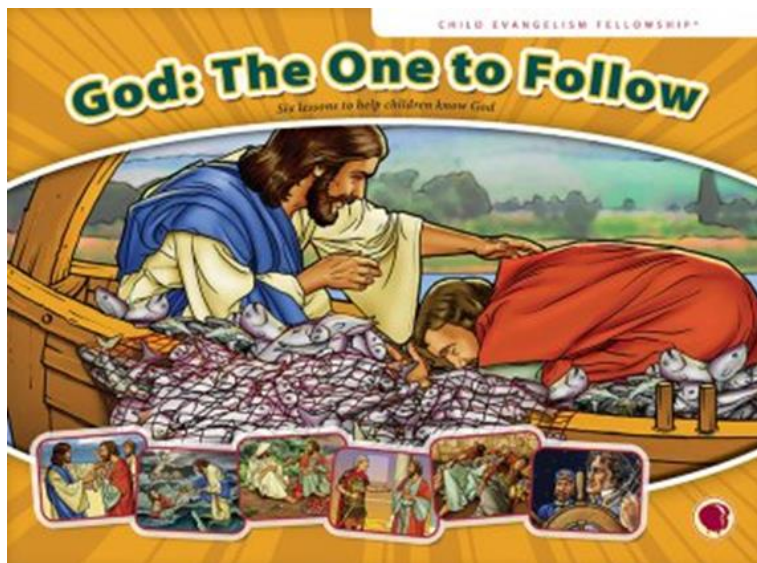
Baptism—We are looking forward to a Baptism service in July. Please let Pastor Tom know if you would like to follow the Lord's call to be Baptized or have any questions.
